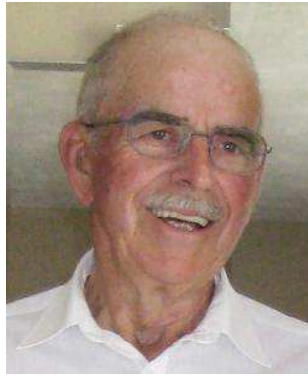


**Paul Léger**
